SUMMER ART in Bristol tonight

Barley Vine Gastropub in Bristol will feature the artwork of Janet Galasso tonight from 6:30 to 9 as part of its Summer Art Night Series.

The Gastropub, at 182 Main St., will offer food and drink specials, and a chance to meet the artist. The show runs through Sept. 18.

Galasso's art is a collection of her latest mixed media works, including work that utilizes recycled metal bottlecaps as well as other mixed media and digital artwork.

Originally trained as a digital artist, Galasso has been working in mixed media for the last three years.

"The process of working

in mixed media isn't all that much different from the process of working digitally, except you are using hand-based techniques instead of the computer as your tool. Much of the process is the same, creating layers, depth, texture, except there's no "undo" key or "history palette" when you make a mistake!"

Galasso, an Oakville native, has a Bachelor of Fine Arts in digital art and design from the C.W. Post Campus in New York, and a masters in education from the University of Bridgeport.
